

Piano Teaching in a changing environment: Update from EPTA UK

New statement: 19 November 2020 (for England, NI & Wales please refer to the statement from 6 November)

The Scottish Government has announced new restrictions taking effect on 20 November 2020 which will see 11 local authorities enter the highest level restrictions (Tier 4) for three weeks.

We continue to monitor guidance from the Scottish Government and other industry professionals. At this time, face to face teaching is permitted in Scotland at all alert level tiers, although singing is not permitted in face to face settings. Your Public Liability Insurance is valid for this work if you follow government guidance in relation to social distancing, ventilation, cleaning and interaction and have completed a risk assessment.
